Notification

Coastal Navigators are advised that Beach landing operations will be conducted involving a 72-metre Landing Craft & support tenders at Dundee Beach.

Date and time of activity:	Commencing 0700 hrs on Tuesday 7 July and concluding approximately 1200 hrs on Friday 10 July 2026. Day and night operations.
Assets/ Vessels involved	72-metre Landing Craft "Matilda 1" and "Support tenders"
Description of Activity:	<p>Coastal Navigators are advised that Beach landing operations will be conducted involving a 72-metre Landing Craft & support tenders to facilitate the loading and unloading of project equipment and cargo at Dundee Beach (12°43'03.95S 130°20'52.60E).</p> <p>The Landing Craft will conduct a series of controlled beach landings (touch and go) during suitable tidal windows. Vessel movements will occur between the offshore anchorage and the beach landing area, with operations coordinated between the vessel and shore personnel.</p> <p>Coastal Navigators are advised to exercise caution when navigating in the vicinity of Dundee Beach during the stated period and maintain a safe distance from the operating vessel(s).</p> <p>Safety measures to minimise impacts on other waterway users include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continuous monitoring of VHF Channel 16 and 72 throughout operations.• Coordination between the vessel master and shore personnel during all landing evolutions.• Operations limited to suitable tidal and weather conditions.• The vessel will display the appropriate navigation lights and shapes in accordance with the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (COLREGs).• Local traffic will be monitored, and, where necessary, the vessel will communicate directly with approaching vessels to ensure safe passage around the operational area.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The beach landing area will be managed by personnel onshore to maintain a safe operating zone during vessel movements.
