Mineral Titles Act 2010

General Reservation of Land (RL 32790)

I, Denise Monica Turnbull, Director Mineral Titles, Department of Industry, Tourism and Trade, as the delegate of the Minister for Mining and Industry, under section 113 of the *Mineral Titles Act 2010*:

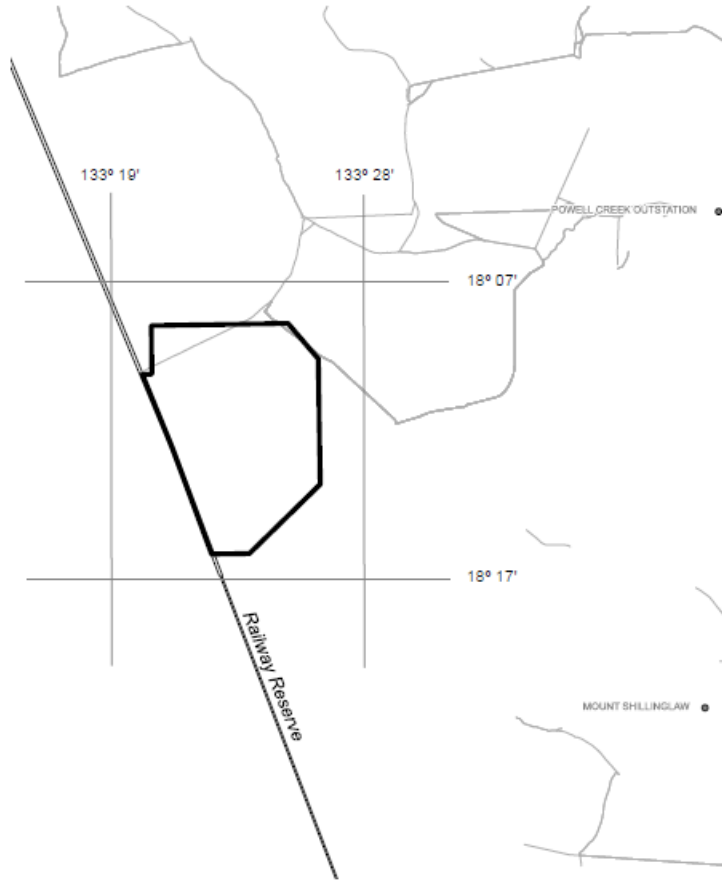
- (a) reserve all the land in the locality of Kekwick that is shown within the thick black lines on the plan in the Schedule from the following activities:
