Kids learn from families by listening, watching and doing.

Meal times

- Talk to babies as you feed them.
- Help kids try to feed themselves or drink from a cup.

In the car

- Talk about where you are going.
- Talk about what you will do when you get there.

In the bath or at the pool

- Kids love to play in the water. They learn what floats and sinks.
- Give kids containers to tip and pour. They learn about 'full' and 'empty'.

Bush trips

- Talk to kids about how to find bush tucker.
- Talk to kids about tracks and what has made them.

At home

- Ask kids to help with jobs around the house.
- Cook things with kids. They learn about healthy foods.

At the shop

- Talk about what you put in the trolley.
- Ask kids to help you find healthy foods.
